- 3) One of the Artists in the Talks does 'improvisation' -- Performers invent stories, characters, and settings on the fly, often starting with audience suggestions. The Second City Theater, which opened in Chicago in 1959, is considered the breeding ground for modern improvisation. Many famous comedians (like Bill Murray, Tina Fey, and Stephen Colbert) started their careers there. Amazing Fact! The original inspiration for improv started with games created by a sociologist to help immigrant children improve their life skills as they adjusted to their new lives. Viola Spolin is considered the mother of modern improve because she studied these children's games and evolved them into the theater games they played at the Second City Theater.

Being able to improv is actually considered a life skill. Coming up with a delicious new recipe out of leftovers or doing a MacGyver (meaning using whatever you have at hand to repair something) are both forms of improv.
